NOTICE OF RACE

1 RULES

- 1.1 The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in *The Racing Rules of Sailing*, the *International Sunfish Class Association Rules* for Sunfish, and the *Windmill Class Association Rules* for Windmills.
- 1.2 Rule 81 shall not apply to this event.

2 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 2.1 The regatta is open to fleets of five or more one-design class boats.
- 2.2 Eligible boats may enter by completing the registration form <u>on-line</u> including payment of the entry fee.
- 2.3 Entries will be accepted until the close of registration, but there will be a discount if paid by June 1, 2024.
- 2.4 Fleets will be scored in their class only.
- 2.5 Sunfish and Windmill owners *must* be registered in their respective class associations.

3 FEES

3.1 Required fees are as follows:

Entry fee: \$70 for single handed boats; \$80 for double-handed boats \$90 for three-handed boats

Early bird discount: \$10 off fees if paid by June 1, 2024

4 SCHEDULE

- 4.1 Registration: Saturday, August 3, from 8 am to 10 am.
- 4.2 Dates of racing: August 3-4, 2024
- 4.3 7 races will be scheduled.
- 4.4 The scheduled time of the warning signal for the first race is 11 am on Saturday and 10 am on Sunday.
- 4.5 On Sunday no warning signal will be made after 1 pm.

5 SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

The sailing instructions will be available after July 20, 2024, at the regatta website

and at registration.

6 VENUE

All races will be sailed in Presque Isle Bay.

7 THE COURSES

The courses to be sailed will be triangles, windward-leeward, or a combination, depending on conditions and classes entered. The course may not be the same for all classes.

8 PENALTY SYSTEM

RRS 44.1 is changed so that the Two-Turns Penalty is replaced by the One-Turn Penalty.

9 SCORING

- 9.1 One race is required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 9.2 (a) When 3 races or fewer have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores. This changes RRS A2.
 - (b) When 4 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

10 PRIZES

Prizes will be given as follows:

Cups for 1st -3rd in each class

Top Sunfish finisher qualifies for 2025 Sunfish World Championship
